Training and Education Centre of ICAR- IVRI, Pune in collaboration with KNP College of Veterinary Science, Shirwal (MAFSU) organised an Animal Health Camp at Tondal village, Purandar taluka of Pune district on 27th September 2018. Dr SK Das and Dr HP Aithal, Principal Scientists, and Mr D Bhaskara Rao, Technical Officer, IVRI Pune Centre along with faculty and students from KNP College of Veterinary Science participated in the Campe. Dr RN Thombare, LDO, Department of Animal Husbandry along with his team also participated in the health camp. Dr M. Rangnekar, Associate Professor, Department of Animal Reproduction and Gynaecology, KNP College of Veterinary Science, Shirwal coordinated the camp.

The health camp started with the *Gau-pujan*. A total of 154 cattle and buffaloes of 40 farmers were treated and vaccinated in the health camp. Different types of cases recorded were worm infection, ectoparasitic infestation, deficiency disorders, anorexia, agalactia, anoestrus, repeat breeding etc. Pregnancy diagnosis and artificial insemination was also carried out. All animals were vaccinated against Foot and Mouth Disease. Arrangements were also made by the State AH Department to put INAPH ear tags in lactating cows and buffaloes.
