At the outset, Dr Gyanendra Singh, Academic Coordinator & COE, welcomed the Chairman, Members of the Academic Council, Joint Director(s), Head of Divisions and Station Incharges.

Dr S.K. Mendiratta, Joint Director (Academic) & Vice Chairman of the Academic Council extended his heartiest welcome to all the honorable members of the house specially Dr P.K. Shukla, COVAS, DUVASU, Mathura and Dr Ashok K Tiwari, Director, ICAR-CARI, Izatnagar. He briefed the House about the academic activities since the last Academic Council Meeting held on 01.03.2023. He informed that new PG Diploma and Certificate Courses have been started from year 2023-24, as per NEP-2020 & ICAR BSMA, the Teaching Assistantship have been offered to 26 PhD scholars in different disciplines. He also informed that Rs.50 crores have been sanctioned to the IVRI DU for establishment of ICAR-IVRI Global University for the year 2024-25 and 2025-26, Self Study Report of the IVRI Deemed University for the NAAC Accreditation is being worked upon to be submitted soon. A proposal for Rs. 36 crores has also been submitted to the Department of DADF, Government of India for strengthened the UG Teaching activities.

The Vice Chancellor & Chairman of the Academic Council Dr Triveni Dutt, extended his heartiest welcome to the Honorable expert members of the House Dr P.K. Shukla, Dean, COVAS, DUVASU, Mathura and Dr Ashok K Tiwari, Director, ICAR-CARI, Izatnagar. The Chairman briefed the House about the recent achievements of ICAR-IVRI Deemed University and appreciated the initiatives taken by the IVRI Deemed University. The Chairman further expressed the need to revisit our priorities in view of Government directives/decisions and the requirement of Industry. He stressed upon the need for increased civic contribution by way of enhanced extension programme, liaison with the State Line Departments and increased Industry linkages and making the Deemed University a Multi-Disciplinary Research Institute and also exploring the possibilities of increased externally funded projects getting approved for the Institute. He also informed about the recent Gazette Notification 2023 for the Deemed to be University issued by the UGC, New Delhi. Keeping in view the implementation of NEP-2020, one Academic Hub at Bengaluru in coordination with IVRI Bengaluru Campus, ICAR-NIANP, ICAR-NIVEDI, Bengaluru and another Academic Hub at Hyderabad in coordination with ICAR-Directorate of Poultry Research and ICAR-National Meat Research Institute, Hyderabad. He also stressed upon the need to have some new 4 years' UG programmes. The Chairman expressed hope to achieve the targets with the help of esteemed colleagues of ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar and its Campuses/ Regional Stations/ Regional Centres.

Dr. P.K. Shukla, Hon'ble Member in his remark appreciated the initiatives taken by IVRI Deemed to be University and thanks to the Chairman, Academic Council for presenting road map of new activities and programmes in a very well way. He said that now the time is changed & it is the correct time that we will move forward at the earliest from single discipline to multidisciplinary education and should be ready for transforming. He also advised to prepare documents for effective presentation to get good ranking in NAAC accreditation. He said that being a Veterinary professional it's our duty to keep healthy to animals/birds/livestock.

Dr. Ashok K Tiwari, Hon'ble Member welcomed the Members of the Academic Council. He appreciated the academic activities of the Deemed University. He said that without resources it is very difficult to run proposed courses under NEP, 2020. He also said that it is our duty to comply all rules/ regulations of the UGC so we could get good ranking. He emphasized the submission of research papers in the higher Impact factor. He also said that the Technologies released by us, must go to ground level/ farmers for their benefits.

Dr. Gyanendra Singh, Academic Coordinator & COE made a brief presentation on the academic activities of previous years/courses conducted/ offered & other activities of Deemed University. He informed the House that Deemed to be University is processing the SSR for NAAC registration. The Deemed to be University also starting the Academic Hub at Bengaluru and Hyderabad from the session.

With the permission of Chair, agenda item was presented by the Academic Coordinator for its approval of the House.
