Shri Mithlesh Kumar, Senior Finance and Accounts Officer and Shri Karunesh Shukla, Assistant Registrar were invited as special invitee in the meeting for wider discussion especially on financial implications for initiation of new programmes/ courses proposed under National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 etc.

Dr R.C. Agrawal, Deputy Director General (Agril. Education), ICAR, Dr M.S. Chauhan, Vice Chancellor, GBPUAT, Pantnagar, Dr M.K. Singh, Senior Scientist and Dr Ajay Kumar, Senior Scientist, could not attend the meeting due to their pre-occupation.

At the outset, Dr Gyanendra Singh, Academic Coordinator & COE, welcomed the Chairman & Members of the Academic Council to the meeting.

Dr S.K. Mendiratta, Joint Director (Academic) & Vice Chairman of the Academic Council extended his heartiest welcome to all the honorable members of the house specially expert members Dr R.R.B. Singh, Dr. O.P. Dhanda, Dr Amresh Kumar and Dr P.K. Shukla. He briefed the House about the academic activities since the last Academic Council Meeting held on 04.09.2023. He informed that new PG/ UG Programmes, MSc Agriculture Economics and Agriculture Statistics, MBA in Agri-Business Management, B.Tech. (Biotechnology) and various PG Diploma/ Certificate Courses and the Academic Hubs at Bengaluru (in association with ICAR-NIVEDI and ICAR-NIANP) and Academic Hub at Hyderabad (in association with ICAR-DPR) have become operational from year 2023-24. As per NEP-2020 & ICAR BSMA, the Teaching Assistantship have been offered to 35 PhD scholars in different disciplines for the academic session 2023-24. He also informed that Rs.80 lakhs received from the Council under PG Development funds during 2023-24 for Upgradation of classrooms facilities at Izatnagar, Mukteswar and Bengaluru Campuses has been deposited with the CPWD. The IQAC of the IVRI Deemed to be University has been established and the Self Study Report of the IVRI Deemed University for the NAAC

Accreditation is in the final stage for submission soon. The Board of Studies and Academic Council have been re-structured as per revised UGC Notification 2023 and the Board of Management has been proposed to the ICAR for approval. The appointment of Ombudspersons has been done while the Professors of Practice have been identified and are being submitted to the Academic Council for its consideration and approval. Feedback system after each semester and more than 30 value added courses have been introduced. A significant increase in the revenue generation over 2022-23 has been recorded during current financial year. Future Plans including establishment of Academic Hub at Hisar in association with ICAR-CIRB and ICAR-NRC on Equines were informed.

The Vice Chancellor & Chairman of the Academic Council, Dr Triveni Dutt extended his heartiest welcome to the Honorable expert members of the House Dr R.R.B. Singh, Dr. O.P. Dhanda, Dr Amresh Kumar, Dr P.K. Shukla and Dr Ashok K Tiwari. The Chairman, while mentioning that the Academic Council is the most important policy making body of the University, briefed the House about the recent achievements of ICAR-IVRI Deemed University and appreciated the initiatives taken by the IVRI Deemed University. The Chairman further expressed the need to revisit our priorities in view of Government directives/ decisions and the requirement of Industry. He stressed upon the need for increased civic contribution by way of enhanced extension programme, liaison with the State Line Departments and increased Industry linkages and making the Deemed University a Multi-Disciplinary Research Institute and also emphasizes to explore the possibilities of increased externally funded projects for the Institute. He also informed that in view of the Gazette Notification 2023 of the UGC for the Deemed to be University, Academic Council and Board of Studies of the Deemed to be University have been re-structured. The Board of Management has been proposed to ICAR for approval as per UGC notification. Keeping in view the implementation of NEP-2020, one Academic Hub at Bengaluru in coordination with IVRI Bengaluru Campus, ICAR-NIANP, ICAR-NIVEDI and another Academic Hub at Hyderabad in coordination with ICAR-Directorate of Poultry Research has become operational from academic year 2023-24. He also stressed upon the need to have some new 4 years' UG programmes since UG and PG programmes were the flagship activities of the Institute and go a long way in making the Deemed University to Institute of global repute. The Institute is also providing National service through CADRAD for attending diagnostic outbreak, Centre for Wildlife for providing health advice to all Zoos, Rescue Centres & Safaris, Biological Standardization Division working as the only Government Analyst in the Country for Quality Control of various biologicals used in the Country, Antigen and Antisera being supplied and a Referral Veterinary Polyclinic. During 2023-24, he informed that a total 368 students were admitted to various UG & PG courses. The Chairman expressed hope to achieve the targets with the help of esteemed colleagues of ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar and its Campuses/ Regional Stations/Regional Centres for making the Deemed to be University to transforming into the Multi-disciplinary Education and Research University (MERU). As part of the new initiatives including digitization of education, several online and distance learning programme are being introduced by the University from the coming year. Various MoUs have been signed by the Deemed University with Government Agencies, Universities, Companies, Start-ups and entrepreneurs to develop a well defined start-up eco system. Several vaccines, diagnostics, Mobile Apps and value added technologies have been developed by the Institute. As part of Agricultural Business incubation, the Institute has developed 186 entrepreneurs.

Dr R.R.B. Singh Hon'ble Member in his remark appreciated the initiatives taken to start new courses and association with other ICAR Institutions for teaching/ education by IVRI Deemed to be University and expressed his thanks to the Chairman. He said that IVRI scientists have the capacity to achieve targets that they have been assigned to make it an Institute of National Importance.

Dr O.P. Dhanda Hon'ble Member in his remark appreciated the initiatives taken by IVRI Deemed to be University and complimented everyone associated with the development and contribution of the Deemed to be University. He also stressed upon the present challenges being faced to maintain the brand value with depleting manpower.

Dr. Amresh Kumar, hon'ble member presented his views on Academic, Research, outreach programmes of the institute and industry linkages. He expressed great satisfaction on progress made in Academic activities. He said that young bloods passing out from IVRI Deemed to be University are a tool for other institution/universities in view of quality education/teaching of the University. He appreciated for starting new Academic programmes, entrepreneurship programmes and suggested to get more externally funded project including increasing scholarship availability from donors. He also appreciated for increased revenue generation.

Dr. P.K. Shukla, Hon'ble Member in his remark complemented the meticulous planning and implementation of the last Academic Council decisions, while thanking the Chairman, Academic Council for proposing new activities and programmes in a very well thought manner, appreciated the efforts being taken to transform the University into a globally competitive Institute of National Importance. He also expressed the need for converting from single discipline to multidisciplinary education towards transformation of University education.

Dr. Ashok K Tiwari, Hon'ble Member welcomed the Members of the Academic Council. He appreciated the new academic activities of the Deemed University and he congratulated IVRI for the new courses initiation including Academic Hubs establishment for developing the Deemed University into multi-disciplinary education and research University (MERU) having globally competitive advantages. He also suggested for establishment of an academic hub in the North East keeping in view several Animal Sciences ICAR institutes there.

Dr R.N. Chatterjee, Hon'ble Member welcome the Members of the Academic Council. He appreciated IVRI Deemed to be University for the initiative taken by the IVRI is commendable.

Dr B. R. Gulati, Hon'ble Member expressed his heartfelt thanks for considering to be the member of Academic Council of this prestigious institute. He also indicated his willingness to support the activities of the IVRI-DU in future. Further, he requested to consider the ICAR-NIVEDI for the infrastructure development at ICAR-NIVEDI through the development grant of the IVRI-DU.

Dr N.K.S. Gowda, Hon'ble Member welcome the Members of the Academic Council. He thank to IVRI Deemed to be University for establishment of Academic Hub at Bengaluru.

Dr. Gyanendra Singh, Academic Coordinator & COE made a brief presentation on the academic activities of previous years/courses conducted/ offered & other activities of Deemed University. He informed the House that Deemed to be University is processing the SSR for NAAC registration. The Deemed University also initiated the Academic Hub at Bengaluru and Hyderabad from the session 2023-2024.

With the permission of Chair, agenda item was presented by the Academic Coordinator for its approval of the House.
