

Exposure cum interactive visit of public servants of Madagascar

An exposure cum interactive visit of public servants of Madagascar was successfully conducted at ICAR-IVRI today on 8th September, 2025. The visit was part of capacity-building programme that is being organized by the National Centre for Good Governance (NCGG) on Public Policy and Governance for Civil Servants of Madagascar. The programme is a part of the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between NCGG and the National School of Administration of Madagascar (ENAM).
