

MoU signed and exchanged between ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar and SKUAST, Jammu

A historic and important MoU was signed and exchanged between the ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar (IVRI) and Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST)- Jammu. Under this agreement, researchers/ scholars are now allowed to work for research and educational activities seamlessly at both institutes.



Institute Director and Vice-Chancellor **Dr Triveni Dutt** stressed the need for more and more collaborations/MoUs with academic institutions for the exchange of knowledge and sharing of resources to make IVRI Deemed University a global university. Dr Dutt said that with this agreement between ICAR-IVRI and Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology, Jammu, further possibilities of cooperation in the frontier areas of research, teaching, and extension.

On this occasion, the Vice Chancellor of Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST)- Jammu, **Dr. B.N. Tripathi**, said that Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology of Jammu was separated from SKUAST Kashmir on 20 September 1999. This university has also signed several MoUs with foreign universities, including the University of Western Australia. Describing ICAR-IVRI as the Mecca-Medina of veterinary medicine, he said that having an MOU with ICAR-IVRI will help their faculty and students to work in the related field.



Joint Director (Academic) Dr S. K. Mendiratta welcomed everyone on this occasion and said that internship students of BVSC and AH will get the opportunity to learn from other institutions such as Sher-e-Kashmir University of Agricultural Sciences and Technology (SKUAST)- Jammu, which is a multi-campus university.

The MoU exchange ceremony was conducted by Dr Gyanendra Singh, Academic Coordinator, Deemed University, and the vote of thanks was proposed by Dr Rajat Garg, Coordinator (UG). Joint Director (Research), Dr SK Singh, Joint Director (Extension Education), Dr Rupasi Tiwari, and other officers of IVRI deemed university were present in this function.
