



Organized training for progressive farmers at Goalpara, Assam under NEH programme



January 10, 2025: ICAR-Indian Veterinary Research Institute, Izatnagar organized a skill training jointly with ICAR- National Research Centre on Pig, Rani and KVK Goalpara, Assam on 7 and 8th January, 2025. The training entitled **‘SCIENTIFIC PIG REARING FOR QUALITY PIGLET PRODUCTION’** was organized under NEH flagship programme. Six crucial aspects of pig production like improved breeds, housing, feeding, breeding plan, major diseases and biosecurity measures were covered in the training. Practical session was also carried out on application of disinfections in pig shed, and identification of healthy and illing animals. Total 38 progressive farmers participated from the two adjoining villages of KVK Goalpara, Assam. Various pig production issues like sampling, disease diagnosis, farm biosecurity measures for African swine fever, piglet mortality, and abortion were addressed during farmer interaction session.

The whole programme was coordinated by Dr. C. Jana, Principal Scientist, ICAR-IVRI, Dr P. Kar, Scientist, ICAR-NRC on Pig and Dr H. Chaudhury, SMS, ICAR-KVK Goalpara, Assam. Feedbacks of training were collected from farmers. Participants conveyed their appreciation to both the institutes for such livelihood support initiatives.
