

Launch of Post Graduate Diploma on Animal Welfare and Veterinary Jurisprudence (Online/Hybrid mode) at ICAR-IVRI

The one year “Post Graduate Diploma on Animal Welfare and Veterinary Jurisprudence” in Online/Hybrid mode offered by Division of Medicine and Livestock Production & Management (LPM, ICAR-IVRI) was inaugurated on 3rd August, 2024 virtually in presence of Dr. D. B. Mondal, HD, Medicine and Dr Mukesh Singh, In-charge LPM. The Dr.B.H.M . Patel and Dr. Akhilesh Kumar will be the Course Coordinator, and Dr. Hari Om Pandey, Dr. R. Raguvaran, and Dr. K. Mahendran will be Co-coordinators along with other faculty members for successful implementation of this programme. The entire programme will be covered in two semesters and is aimed at equipping the participants with knowledge of animal welfare issues, animal right, laws ensuring animal welfare, animal welfare organizations, minimum welfare standards of domestic, wild and pets along with role of veterinarians in ensuring animal welfare.
