

The Input distribution programme was organised under Development Action Plan for Scheduled Tribes (DAPST) for BPL tribal farmers from Khatima block, Uddham Singh Nagar, Uttarakhand by ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar on 25th & 26th March, 2025

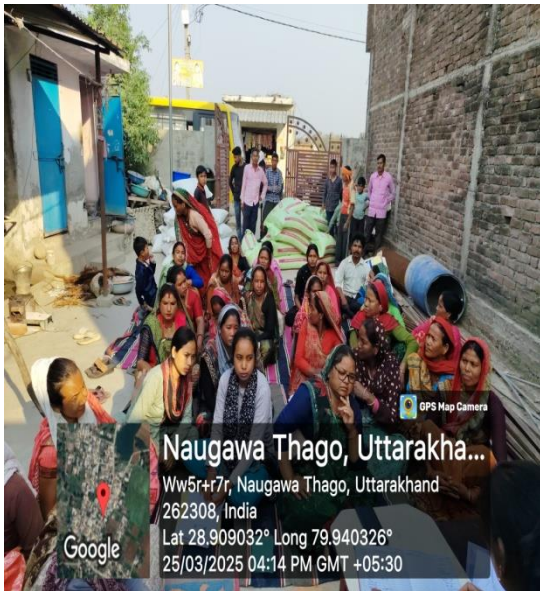
On March 25, 2025, ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar, organized an input distribution program for tribal farmers from Naugawa Thago village in the Khatima Block of Udham Singh Nagar district, Uttarakhand, under the Tribal Sub-Plan (TSP) initiative.

During the program, a total of 1000 kg of poultry feed was distributed among 20 tribal farmers living below the poverty line, all of whom had previously participated in a training program organized at ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar. Each beneficiary received 50 kg of poultry feed. Additionally, 1000 kg of goat feed was distributed to 10 beneficiaries, with each farmer receiving 100 kg of feed. Additionally, as part of the project, 50 goats (40 female and 10 male) were distributed among 10 beneficiaries. Each tribal farmer received four female goats and one male goat on March 26, 2025.

The event was coordinated by Dr. Madan Singh, Project Investigator, and was supported by Dr. Shruti, Dr. Ram Singh Suman and Dr Vikrant Chouhan, Project Associates for the TSP project.
