

## TEC ICAR-IVRI Pune distributed goats, and organised training and *Kisan Goshti* in Hingoli district (Maharashtra) under SCSP programme during 31<sup>st</sup> Oct - 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2023

TEC ICAR-IVRI Pune in collaboration with State Animal Husbandry Department and College of Veterinary and Animal Science, Parbhani, organised various programmes such as training at *Sirsam* (taluka and district Hingoli), resource inputs distribution and *Kisan Goshti* at *Wadhiwara* village (Sengaon taluka of Hingoli district), under SCSP programme during 31<sup>st</sup> Oct to 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2023.

One day training-workshop was organized on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2023 at Gram Panchayat Office *Sirsam* on the topic “**वैज्ञानिक पशुपालन व्यवसायाचे तंत्र**” (Scientific goat rearing). A total of 367 farmers including a large number of women actively participated in the training programme. Dr Sandeep Narwade, LDO, Veterinary Hospital at *Sirsam* welcomed the guests and participants and briefed about the aims and objectives of the training for the livelihood improvement of SC farmers. District Animal Husbandry Officer Dr Sakharam Baburao Khune, ACAH Hingoli and Chief Guest of the function, guided the participants about various schemes of Animal Husbandry department. Dr Sanghratna Bahire, Scientist, TEC Pune spoke on scientific goat rearing and integrated farming system. Dr Tukaram Bhuktar, Farm manager, Veterinary College, Parbhani, highlighted the importance of nutrition and fodder management. Dr Pathade Santosh, LDO, explained the importance of dairy cattle management and gave guidance on dairy business. Others present on the occasion were Dr Prashant Mahajan, Dr Ravi Bunde, Dr Sai Pawar and Dr Siddharth S Ingole. At the completion of training, certificates were distributed to all the participants. The program was coordinated by Dr Sanghratna Bahire and Dr Sandeep Narwade.

On 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2023, a *Kisan Goshti* was organised at *Wadhiwara* Gram Panchayat, and about 45 farmers actively participated. The farmers were informed about the importance of animal husbandry practices in household economy. Important aspects of scientific management of dairy, goat and poultry farming including the ways to make it profitable was discussed in length. The farmers were informed about farmer-producer company and its importance. The farmers were also made aware about the climate change and the importance of plantation for livestock fodder in scarcity and promoting plantation at village level. Dr Tukaram Bhuktar, COVAS, Parbhani, Mr Vijay Sakharam Kawane, Ex-Registrar Adarsh College, Hingoli, and Gram Panchayat members Mr Arvind P Pole, Mr Baburao Pole and villagers including the beneficiaries were present.

The goat distribution programme was organised in the evening of 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov 2023. 7 SC beneficiary farmers selected by local NGO and LDO received Osmanabadi goats (1-2 year old, 4F+1M for each farmer; total 35 goats), along with feed (200 kg/farmer), feeder (5x2x8” size/farmer) waterer (10 L/farmer), mineral mixture, medicine and tarpaulin (15x15 ft/farmer). During the occasion, Dr Tukaram Bhuktar, welcomed the guests and farmers. In his address, he told the farmers to maintain the goats properly, and he thanked IVRI Pune for their efforts to improve the livelihood of resource poor SC farmers through different livelihood programmes. Dr Sanghratna Bahire addressed the farmers and informed about the activities of the Centre, objectives of the SCSP programme and gave tips on livestock management, goat feeding and marketing.

A follow up visit was made on 30<sup>th</sup> Oct and 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 2023 to record the present status of the *desi* birds distributed in *Ajegaon* area. Twenty five farmers were visited on their farm/door. The newly distributed batch attained about 1.5 kg live weight and were not yet laying eggs. The data collected on the availability of birds, mortality, number of eggs produced and earnings etc were recorded.
