Hard copy of Applications completed in all respect alongwith all enclosures (thesis etc.) must reach the undersigned latest by 13<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 positively. The applications of candidates posted in the Aandaman & Nicobar Island, Lakshadweep, State/Union Territory in the North-Eastern region, Ladakh Division of J&K and Sikkim are entertained by 19 December, 2019. Applications received after the last date will not be entertained and liable to be rejected. Postal delay will not be accepted as a legitimate reason to entertain application received after the last date. .

## RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DR. C.M. SINGH AWARD

1. **Name of Award:** "IVRI-Dr. C.M. Singh Award" for best PhD Scholar of Indian Veterinary Research Institute.
  2. **Donor of the Award:** Dr C.M. Singh Endowment Trust, A-336, Rajendra Nagar, Bareilly, U.P.
  3. **Nature of Award:** A gold plated silver medal with a certificate of honour.
  4. **Periodicity of Award:** The Award shall be given once a calendar year.
  5. **Eligibility of Award:** The Ph.D scholar in any subject of veterinary and Animal Sciences of IVRI who have submitted thesis and successfully completed the final viva-voce examination during the particular calendar year. To be eligible for consideration of award the candidate must have record of good conduct. The Ph.D scholar who secured "F" grade in any course during his/her Ph.D programme shall not qualify for consideration of the award.
  6. **Administration of the Award:** The institute shall have the absolute right for selection of the recipient of the award and formulation of rules governing such selection. The decision of the Institute will be final and binding on all aspirants and will not be challengeable in any court of law.
  7. **Judging Committee:** There shall be a Judging Committee with the following members:

1. Joint Director (Academic)	Chairman
2. Joint Director (Research)	Member
3. Joint Director (Ext. Edn.)	Member
4. Joint Director (CADRAD)	Member
5. One Head of Division nominated by Chairman every year	Member
6. An Eminent Scientist not below the rank of Prof./Principal Scientist in any field of Veterinary Science nominated by JD(Academic)	Member
7. Registrar/Deputy Registrar	Member Secretary
- Any five members including the chairman will form the quorum of the committee meeting.
8. **Procedure for Selection of the Recipient:**
    - a. A circular will be issued from the university well in time seeking applications from the PhD scholars. Applications must reach the university within 21 days time.
    - b. The award may be withheld by the Academic Council if in their opinion sufficiently meritorious candidates are not forthcoming in the particular year.
    - c. After acceptance of the recommendations of the Judging Committee by the Academic Council, the awardee will be announced.
  9. **Presentation of the Award:**

The award shall be presented to the candidate at the Annual Convocation of the institute or any other suitable occasion. The selection of the awardee will be intimated to the Trust.

10. Evaluation of the awardee will be made by scoring as follows:

**Part-I Academic Records: (Total : 25 marks)**

- a) High school -- 2.5 marks (1<sup>st</sup> Div.:2.5, 2<sup>nd</sup> Div :1.5 marks, 3<sup>rd</sup> Div : 1.0 marks)
- b) Intermediate -- 2.5 marks(1<sup>st</sup> Div : 2.5, 2<sup>nd</sup> Div :1.5 marks, 3<sup>rd</sup> Div : 1.0 marks)
- c) B.V.Sc & A.H. -- 5.0 marks (Proportionate to 10.00 or 4.00 scale)
- d) M.V.Sc -- 5.0 marks (Proportionate to 10.00 or 4.00 scale)
- e) Ph.D -- 10.0 marks (Proportionate to 10.00 or 4.00 scale)

**Part-II : Thesis Research (Ph.D): 40 marks**

- a) Based on reports of the thesis made by the external examiner for award of the degree --10 marks
- b) Evaluation of Expert/ Judging Committee at the time of Assessment for the award based on contribution towards advancement of knowledge --30 marks

**Part-III : Research Publications : (Total : 20 marks)**

- a) Research papers- 15 marks (NAAS Equated)
- b) Research paper presented in the conference (oral & posters)- 5 marks

**Part-IV : Achievement/Awards & honours : (Total: 5 marks)**

**Part-V : Extra Curricular activities : (Total : 10 marks)**

- a) Dramas/Debates
  - b) Games & Sports
  - c) Cultural Activities
  - d) Fine Arts & Literary activities, etc.
- In case of tie among the recommended candidates, the award shall be decided on the basis of OGPA in Ph.D programme. In case, OGPA in Ph.D are same, the OGPA in MVSc will be taken into consideration.
  - Atleast 60 marks shall have to be scored by the candidate for consideration of the award.
