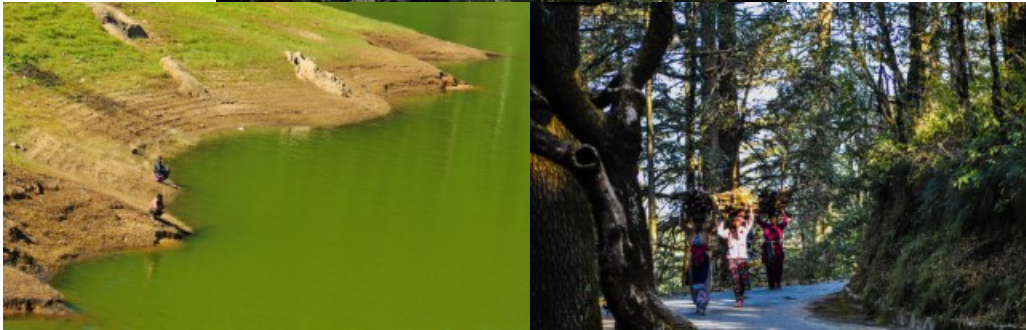

**Endangered species: Saviors of Planet earth**

India is home to a variety of species, and rich flora and fauna. This country's biodiversity is what makes our country so beautiful. India is a biodiversity hotspot with all the species that we have, there are some that are on the edge of extinction and known as endangered species. India accounts for 7 to 8% of all recorded species, including over 5100 species of plants and 11,000 species of animals in which 600 are endangered animal species. The IUCN Red List has declared the animal endangered because of the constant decrease of its population since 2018. Such as Lion and Gharial. IUCN, One World Conservation in 2015, Bengal Tiger in 1966 and Red tiger in 2011 only.

**Reasons for the endangerment:**

- Deforestation, mining and agriculture.
- Loss of habitat or the destruction of the natural landscape by human intervention.
- Over hunting and poaching.
- Pollution, especially in the form of plastic.

**Impact:**

The loss of a predator can result in trophic cascades, which making a predator's extinction that can also impact populations of prey, which cause changes ecosystem and food web changes.

**Conservation:**

To save the animals from poaching and hunting they are often kept in a sanctuary and shelter. If pollution can be controlled all across the globe, then it can have a major positive impact on animals, fish and birds all over the world.

A number of breeding programmes have been introduced.

The government, NGOs, and the other agencies should come forward for the wildlife conservation. Educating the endangered animals in the wild.

The objective of this day is to expose students to various facets of agriculture and its relevance to country's development, with the aim to inspire them and attract them towards agriculture.

**To mark the celebration of Agricultural Education Day – 2021 at ICAR-IVRI, Izatnagar, a distinguished lecture was organized for UG students of IVRI. 
