

Section 4(b)(xv): Particulars of facilities available to citizens for obtaining information including the working hours of a library or reading room, if maintained for public use

Means, methods or facilitation available to the public which are adopted by the department for dissemination of information.

The Indian Veterinary Research Institute uses the following means for facilitating the flow of information to the concerned public:

- (i) The National Library of Veterinary Sciences at IVRI has a collection of more than 2,50,000 highly specialized reading material in the form of books, journals, monographs, theses, reference works published data, bulletins, reviews, advances, reports, reprints, micro-documents etc. The library is subscribing about 55 foreign journals and about 70 Indian journals each year. Library is providing full text online access of about three thousand+ journals under CeRA, Education Division, ICAR.
